



## Meeting Minutes

April 2, 2024, 7 p.m.

At Clarkston United Methodist Church

**The meeting was called to order** by Chair Becky Eklund. 18 people were in attendance, plus two guests.

**Candidate presentation:** Congressional candidate Carmela Conroy made a presentation and answered questions.

**Minutes** of the March 5 meeting were approved.

**Finances:** The treasurer reported \$2,149 in the account and no activity for the month.

**Election Observers:** The chair thanked those who had spent time at the Asotin County Courthouse to observe the ballot counting in March.

**Endorsement Policy:** The policy for the group to make candidate endorsements was discussed and approved as an addition to the bylaws for the group. The chair said the May meeting will be moved ahead one week to May 14 to allow discussion of endorsements after the May 10 candidate filing deadline.

**Asotin County issues/platform:** Member Michael Mossler presented some information from the Washington State Democrats and an Asotin County platform from the past. The chair appointed him to head that effort to draft a platform for Asotin County.

**Delegates to State Convention:** The chair gave an update.

**Washington Democratic Central Committee:** The chair reported this group is making grants available for party building and support for community events. The chair said she would check into this.

**Community events:** The group agreed to try to get everything together to have a table at the Asotin County Fair April 27 and 28. The chair, treasurer and secretary will work on the details. Several members offered to help staff the event.

**Get Out the Vote postcards:** The group decided the postcards go out about the same time as the ballots for the primary and general elections. The group decided this would be a July activity.
