

## Minutes of meeting Sept. 3, 2024, 7 p.m.

At Clarkston United Methodist Church

**Meeting called to order** by Chair Becky Eklund. There were 20 people in attendance. Each person present introduced themselves.

**Minutes of the August meeting** had been sent out via email with the notice of the September meeting. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. They were approved by voice vote.

**Financial report** was passed out by Treasurer Roger Jones. The balance in the account at the end of August was \$1,356.54.

**Get Out the Vote campaign** took up the remainder of the meeting. Becky Eklund had pulled together the names of the likely democrats, independent democrats, and independents who didn't vote in the 2022 general election and had divided them into lists by precinct. There were 427 names on the lists She said the executive committee had created handouts with tips and possible messaging for sending postcards, making phone calls, writing letters to the editor and door knocking plus a handout for those interested in helping send postcards and letters to voters in swing states.

The field officer for the Washington state democrats, Codi Gaston, joined the meeting via zoom. Codi explained she will have names soon for those people the campaign would like to reach. The campaign will provide volunteers interested in going door to door with materials. She asked those interested to email her at: <u>Codi@wavictory24.org</u>. She showed Harris yard signs for sale on the web for \$20 and said some groups have bought them and then charged a little more as a moneymaker for their group. Codi said she would supply the Asotin County team with leave-behind door hangars and lists of voters to contact.

Members who were going to wait for the voter lists from Codi were asked to not also use a list the chair had prepared for the Asotin County effort. Many in the group picked up the Asotin County lists and the relevant number of postcards for the number of names on their lists, plus the handouts. All of the voter names the chair had pulled were collected by various members present at the meeting.
